

To all our lovely customers, we will be reopening the pub on Tuesday 14th July.

However, the new normal is going to be a little different for the time being as we must adhere to the Government Guidelines as best we can for the safety of our Staff, Customers and the Local Community.

If you are feeling at all unwell, do not visit us and please stay at home.

Please be vigilant and look out for signs. Points to note: -

- A one-way system will be in place - Entrance will be via the FRONT DOOR ONLY. Please wait there and be patient, when available a member of staff will allow you in.
- Maintain social distance from staff and fellow customers.
- Use the sanitising stations provided at various point inside & outside.
- Pay using contactless where possible.

PUB AND RESTAURANT

Please understand our seating capacity will be reduced.

Bookings are advised - 01606 853327. Walk-ins will be served on a first come first served basis should we have table space available.

Note: The maximum number for any group, booking or walk-in, is 6 people. We can only allow people to sit together inside the pub who are from the same household or are in a social 'bubble'.

Once assigned a table, that table is for you and your group only. Please do not join other groups, swap tables or move furniture around. Everything has been placed where it is to adhere to social distancing.

Standing at the bar or other areas is not permitted!

All tables will be limited to a 2-hour time slot.

GARDEN AND TERRACES

If seated outside and the weather takes a turn for the worse, please be aware that you will not be able to move inside.

Dogs are welcome in the garden and snug but must always be on a lead.

TRACK & TRACE

As set out in the government guidelines all customers must provide contact information either by logging onto our Wi-Fi or written into a diary which will be kept on file for 21 days to support the efforts to beat the virus.

TOILETS

Toilets are via a corridor, so we are asking customers to maintain social distance and be courteous to one another, all entrance doors will be wedged open to make this easier.

Please ensure thorough hand washing prior to leaving the toilets

FOOD

We will be running a slightly reduced food menu to start off with, but still a wide range of your menu favourites. Dietary requirements will be catered for (Please see the menu) .

Menus will be one use only, please retain to order deserts then dispose of once all orders are complete
